I, Ira I. Gunn a resident of Madison County, Alabama, being over the age of twenty-one years of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament, revoking all former wills which may have been made by me.

Item One: It is my will that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my executor hereinafter named, as soon after my death as practicable.

Item Two: I give, devise and bequeath to my wife, Myrna Gunn, all of my estate both real, personal and mixed, of which I may die seized and possessed, to have and to hold in fee simple forever.

Item three: I hereby nominate and appoint my said wife, Myrna Gunn, as executrix of this my last will and testament, and declare that she shall not be required to give any bond for the performance of her duties arising hereunder; nor shall she be required to give any bond for the performance of her duties arising hereunder; not shall she be required to make any inventory of the property coming into her hands as such executrix, nor make any report to any court of her proceedings hereunder.

Item four: Provided however, that should I and my said wife Myrna Gunn died at the same moment of time or should we die under circumstances making it impossible to ascertain who predeceased the other, I give, devise and bequeath my estate as follows:

- a) To my brother, Erle Gunn, all of my real estate and personal property of every kind and nature, wheresoever the same may be situated, except money in the bank, and bonds.
- b) I give and bequeath to the said Erle Gunn, and to my sister, Velma Gunn Collins, share and share alike all money in bank to my credit, whether on savings account or checking account, and all bonds belonging to me at the time of my death.

Item five: In the even my wife and I die at the same moment of time, or under circumstances making it impossible to ascertain who of us predeceased the other, I hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint my brother, Erle Gunn and my sister Velma Gunn Collins, as the executors of this my last will and testament.
